6a – Richard Hale School, Hertford	Additional representation from a neighbour in Highfield Rd. Comment that the proposed container is of poor visual amenity, will deteriorate and is out of keeping. A brick structure is suggested.	Acknowledge that the container is not high quality appearance, but it is a temporary structure that could easily be moved from the site.

	Representation from the <u>Football Association</u> (FA) setting out that the FA and Herts FA have prioritised the project for funding. A crucial element of the investment is to ensure the proposal is financially sustainable and would not require public sector subsidy. To obtain funding they expect the pitch to be open 85 hours per week and the proposed usage times would secure this, however there may be some limited movement on hours of operation. The ethos of the pitch is to provide training/match facilities for FA Charter Standard Clubs (Bengeo Tigers / Hertford Town Youth) who have set procedures for Player Code of Conduct, Parent/Supporters Code of Conduct and adhere to the FA RESPECT campaign.	

	In relation to the acoustic treatment hey further to Bedfordshire FA Headquarters where a pitch is 18 metres from neighbours and the 2metre high fence has resulted in acceptable neighbour impact.	
5b Brewery Yard Watton Road Ware	It is understood that Members have been circulated with a representation from a resident of Black Swan Court, to the south of the site, setting out issues in relation to the impact that access to the site will have in relation to current vehicle parking for neighbouring occupiers.
