	The proposal in this report is to deliver many of the intended aims of the earlier ANPR-based enforcement proposal by way of the more 'orthodox' method of deploying a Civil Enforcement Officer to sensitive areas such as school 'zig-zags'.
	Although the primary purpose of enforcement is to secure compliance with parking regulations it is likely that a small amount of additional penalty charge income will be generated through the deployment of this additional CEO.
