Legal:	The Council's Procurement Officer confirms that the ESPO Framework Agreement may be used to purchase the new car park management system.
Financial:	The financial implications of these proposals are summarised in the body of the report and are set out in fuller form in Essential Reference Paper C and Essential Reference Paper D .
Human Resource:	N/A
Risk Management:	The risks associated with the consideration of the implementation of an alternative 'pay on exit' car park management system within the Gascoyne Way (Hertford) and Jackson Square (Bishop's Stortford) multi-storey car parks are presented in Essential Reference Paper C . Should member wish to continue to progress 'pay on exit' in these car parks a detailed structural and operational survey would need to be undertaken.
Health and wellbeing – issues and impacts:	A barrier controlled system requiring the insertion of a validated ticket to exit will require the Council to consider options to support the car park's use by blue badge holders. These could include requiring the motorist to make contact with a member of staff upon arrival or departure, to pre-register their badge and vehicle registration number with the Council or to pay for their parking.
