Financial:	 The tariff changes proposed in ERP C are designed to generate approx. £225k additional income from 2017/18. The further changes proposed in ERP E are designed to generate approx. £35k additional income from 2017/18. The above estimates are based on an assumption that current volumes of car park use will remain unchanged. The introduction of new 'pay and display' machines in October 2016 is likely to result in changed patterns of use of East Herts' car parks, the results of which will be monitored closely during 2017/18.
