	<p>(B) Supports, in principle, the general economic benefits that expansion of the airport would bring to both East Herts residents and the wider Luton, Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire areas;</p> <p>(C) Considers that LLAL should explore measures to improve East-West connections to both serve the airport and support the wider Oxford-Cambridge corridor;</p> <p>(D) Notwithstanding (C), reserves its position in respect of surface access matters until such time as evidence becomes available to allow for full consideration of such issues in due course;</p> <p>(E) Reserves its position in respect of environmental impact until such time as evidence becomes available to allow for full consideration of such issues in due course.</p>
