Decision:	Delegation to Oliver Rawlings, Service Manager – Licensing and Enforcement, acting in consultation with the Chair of the Licensing Committee, of the authority to determine recommendations for the suspension or revocation of taxi vehicle licences arising from lack of documentation and/or the condition of the vehicle. That this delegated authority remains in place until it is rescinded
Reason(s) for Decision:	To enable authority at the most appropriate level within the organisation so as to effect swift decision-making
Details of alternative options, if any, considered and rejected:	Not granting this onward delegation – REJECTED as this would retain this authority at the Head of Housing and Health level which, due to current pressures on time, runs the risk of decisions being unduly delayed.
