

NOTICE OF LEADER'S DECISION – DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS

Subject	Amending the Officer's scheme of delegation
Executive Member	Cllr Linda Haysey, Leader of the Council
Decision	To give delegated authority on Footpaths to the Head of Planning under Part 3C, paragraph 15 of the Constitution.
Reason for decision	<p>To improve the efficiency and effectiveness of decision-making for footpath orders.</p> <p>The Constitution currently does not delegate the protection, creation, diversion, modification and extinguishment of footpaths/bridleways under the Head of Planning.</p> <p>It is currently not delegated in the Constitution.</p>
Authority given	<p>The Leader may amend the scheme of delegation relating to Executive functions at any time during the year by giving written notice to the Monitoring Officer and to the person, body or committee concerned. The notice must set out the extent of the amendment to the scheme of delegation and whether it entails the withdrawal of delegation from any person, body, committee or the Executive as a whole. The appropriate amendments to the constitution will be made by the Monitoring Officer. This will have immediate effect and the change(s) will be referred to Council annually within the Constitution. (Part 4D, Para 1.5.2)</p>
Options considered	Without making this decision, footpath orders are unable to be authorised.
