<u>RECOMMENDATION</u> - that the Hertfordshire County Council and Hertfordshire Police Authority's precepts be noted.

- 1.1 The County Council's Finance Director has advised that the County Council and Policy Authority precepts for 2005/06 as they affect East Hertfordshire District Council taxpayers will total £57,934,692.58. This is made up of £51,459,425.82 for the County Council and £6,475,266.76 for the Police Authority, giving Band D equivalents of £938.47 and £118.09 respectively.
