<u>'D' RECOMMENDATION</u> - that the Hertfordshire County Council and Hertfordshire Police Authority's precepts be noted.

1.0 <u>Background</u>

- 1.1 The County Council's Finance Director has advised that the County Council and Policy Authority precepts for 2006/07 as they affect East Hertfordshire District Council taxpayers will total £61,942,046.39. This is made up of £55,016,834.78 for the County Council and £6,925,211.61 for the Police Authority, giving Band D equivalents of £984.95 and £123.98 respectively.

- 2.1 The County Council and Police Authority precepts contribute to the setting of the Council Tax. The setting of the Council Tax contributes to the health and sustainability of the organisation.
