<u>'D' RECOMMENDATION</u> - that the Hertfordshire County Council and Hertfordshire Police Authority's precepts be noted.

- 1.0 <u>Background</u>
- 1.1 The County Council's Finance Director has advised that the County Council and Policy Authority precepts for 2007/08 as they affect East Hertfordshire District Council taxpayers will total £66,507,330.89. This is made up of £59,071,739.32 for the County Council and £7,435,591.57 for the Police Authority, giving Band D equivalents of £1034.13 and £130.17 respectively.
