<u>'D' RECOMMENDATION</u> - that the Hertfordshire County Council and Hertfordshire Police Authority's precepts be noted.

- 1.0 Background
- 1.1 The County Council's Finance Director has advised that the County Council and Policy Authority precepts for 2008/09 as they affect East Hertfordshire District Council taxpayers will total £70,574,023.68. This is made up of £62,653,650.04 for the County Council and £7,920,373.64 for the Police Authority, giving Band D equivalents of £1,081.12 and £136.67respectively.

- 2.1 The County Council and Police Authority precepts contribute to the setting of the Council Tax. East Herts District Council is the billing authority for the District and the setting of Council Tax is therefore a statutory duty of the Council.
