1.0 <u>Background</u>

- 1.1 At Appendix 'A9' (pages 3.3 3.4) there is set out a list of Parish Councils and their precepts for 2008/09. There is a statutory requirement on a precepting authority to notify the District Council of its requirements by 1 March.
- 1.2 Total Parish net expenditure is estimated for 2008/09 as £3,391,441 compared with the requirements of £3,267,788 in 2007/08.
