425 COMPLAINT IN RESPECT OF TOWN COUNCILLORS: REFERENCE BSTC/01/2009

The Monitoring Officer submitted a report on a complaint that Town Councillors J Wyllie and C Woodward had breached the provisions of Bishop's Stortford Town Council's Code of Conduct

The complaint had been referred to the Monitoring Officer for investigation by the Review Sub-Committee.

The Committee noted the details of the complaint.

The Monitoring Officer drew Members' attention to the Investigating Officer's report on the complaint appended to his report.

The Investigating Officer had found that there had been no breach of the Code of Conduct by Town Councillors Wyllie and Woodward.

The Committee noted that it was required to consider the Investigating Officer's report and make one of the following findings:

- to accept a finding of no failure;
- to refer the matter to a hearing of the Standards Committee;
- to refer the matter to the Adjudication Panel for England for determination.

The Committee considered the details of the Investigating Officer's report, the relevant legislation and protocols and the evidence gathered. It noted the reasons identified by the Investigating Officer for reaching the finding now detailed.

The Committee also considered all the evidence submitted, including the evidence submitted by the complainant.

The Committee agreed to accept the finding that there had been no failure by Councillors Wyllie and Woodward to comply with Bishops' Stortford Town Council's Code of Conduct.

RESOLVED – that, in relation to complaint reference BSTC/01/2009, the Investigating Officer's finding that there had been no failure by Councillors Wyllie and Woodward to comply with Bishop's Stortford Town Council's Code of Conduct be accepted.
