Consideration of Call-in – 3 options for the Committee

## Refer matter back to Executive

The Scrutiny Committee would need to set out its concerns in writing. An Executive meeting will need to be convened within 21 working days, amending the decision or not.

Executive confirms original decision

Executive amends original decision

## **Refer matter to Council**

The matter can be dealt with at next Council meeting

## Do nothing

The decision will be implemented as originally agreed.

If Council objects, it will refer matter back to Executive. Council cannot make decisions in respect of an Executive decision, unless it is contrary to the policy framework or inconsistent with the budget. An Executive meeting will be convened within 10 working days to reconsider its decision.

If Council does not object to decision, no further action and original decision can be implemented.
