3	Member Havers Park Bowls Club	Harlow	Yes	Unfair to other businesses in the area and people working from home; would prefer commuter type waiting restriction in place of proposed bays providing everyone with a fairer chance to park
4	Local resident with connection to Bowls club	Bishop's Stortford	Yes	Bowls club members / visitors will find reduced space to park; elderly members of society carry weighty four Woods (three lbs each) and it may be impossible for them to continue playing; believes the financial compensation to businesses losing parking space should be sufficient without Council funding alternative parking
5	Local resident	Bishop's Stortford	Yes	There are no parking facilities except Havers Lane after 10.30am; what right does Millars Three business have to take over a public strip of road?; local residents should be able to apply for permits; refers to mistake in plan diagram where bay crosses Bowls Club gates; Compensation to Millars Three should be sufficient without use of highway
6	Assistant Town Clerk	Bishop's Stortford Town Council	Yes	Town Council Planning and environmental Committee believe it is not appropriate for free permits to be available to Millars Three when local residents experience difficulty; permits should be issued to local residents
7	Connection to Bowls club	Thorley	Yes	Proposal will make parking for bowls club members & visiting teams impossible (very difficult currently); Club survival may be an issue if other clubs decline to play at the club because of parking restrictions
8	Local resident	Bishop's Stortford	Yes	Very worried about the ability to park close to home as it is sometimes impossible now; unfair to issue permits to businesses over local residents; this elderly resident has concerns about walking a distance at night

9	Honorary Ladies Secretary Havers Park Bowls Club	Bishop's Stortford	Yes	Innaccuracies in order & map in relation to start of Southmill Road - yardage shown incorrect; taxi rank listed as overnight rank; believes schedule 1 & 2 should correspond i.e. permit places order times should be duplicated for 01 restriction (my interpretation); there is a car park in the goods yard that could accommodate the cars that will lose spaces; permits should not be FREE and the permit scheme should be administered by EHDC and not by Millars Three issuing permits; presumption that the landowner has been compensated for loss of amenity; the proposal may set a precedent for all other residents and businesses in EH adding to current parking chaos; at recent Council meeting it was agreed to implement a waiting restriction o/s Bowls club to prevent taxi parking and this would need to be taken into account before the proposal could be considered
