Question 1

A mill was powered by the water flow of the River Lea at the site of Hertford Theatre for well over 1000 years. There was a positive report about reprovision of water power (hydro power) to Hertford Theatre to the January meeting of the Council's Executive. The aim of the proposal is to cut the Theatre's energy bill; to reduce the national carbon expensive energy demand from the National Grid and to set a good example in the community locally and more widely. Some Hertford Members have consistently pushed for East Herts to take this initiative and develop a plan. Is there a positive update for Members?
