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Purpose/Summary of Report:

 This report describes expressions of interest from MOT testing stations to provide taxi vehicle condition certificate testing facilities.

RECOMMENDATION FOR LICENSING COMMITTEE: That:

(A) An expression of interest from a medical practitioner to be added to the Council's approved list of taxi medical providers be approved.

1.0 <u>Background</u>

- 1.1 Under the Council policy, taxi drivers must obtain a certificate of medical fitness to drive to Group 2 standards. They may obtain the certificate from their own G.P., from the Council's medical adjudicator, which is 'Aviation Medica' at Stansted Airport, or from a Medical Practitioner on the East Herts Council approved list.
- 1.2 An expression of interest has been received From a GP surgery at 22 North Street Bishops Stortford to be added to the list of GP's approved to conduct Group 2 standard medicals for taxi licence applicants.

2.0 Report

- 2.1 An expression of interest was received from Dr Nutley, practising at 22 North Street, Bishops Stortford.
- 2.2 There does not to appear to be any reason to restrict the number of medical practitioners that undertake Group 2 medicals, and an increased number may increase convenience, and reduce costs for applicants.
