Consultation:	Not applicable
Legal:	The Council's policy on vehicle removals is fully compliant with the Statutory Guidance issued by the Secretary of State for Transport emphasises the traffic management purposes of CPE.
Financial:	The proposed ceasing of the vehicle removals project will result in a positive variance of £20,000 in the current financial year and a permanent reduction in base budget of the same amount thereafter.
Human Resource:	There are no human resources issues.
Risk Management:	Failure to approve the recommended ceasing of the vehicle removals project will result in full expenditure of £20,000 required to operate the service with a significantly high probability that no results will be achieved due to the severe limitations on the solution able to be implemented on an operational basis.
