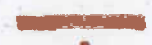


UNLISTED BUILDINGS/FEATURES CONSIDERED OF SUFFICIENT QUALITY TO BECOME LISTED.

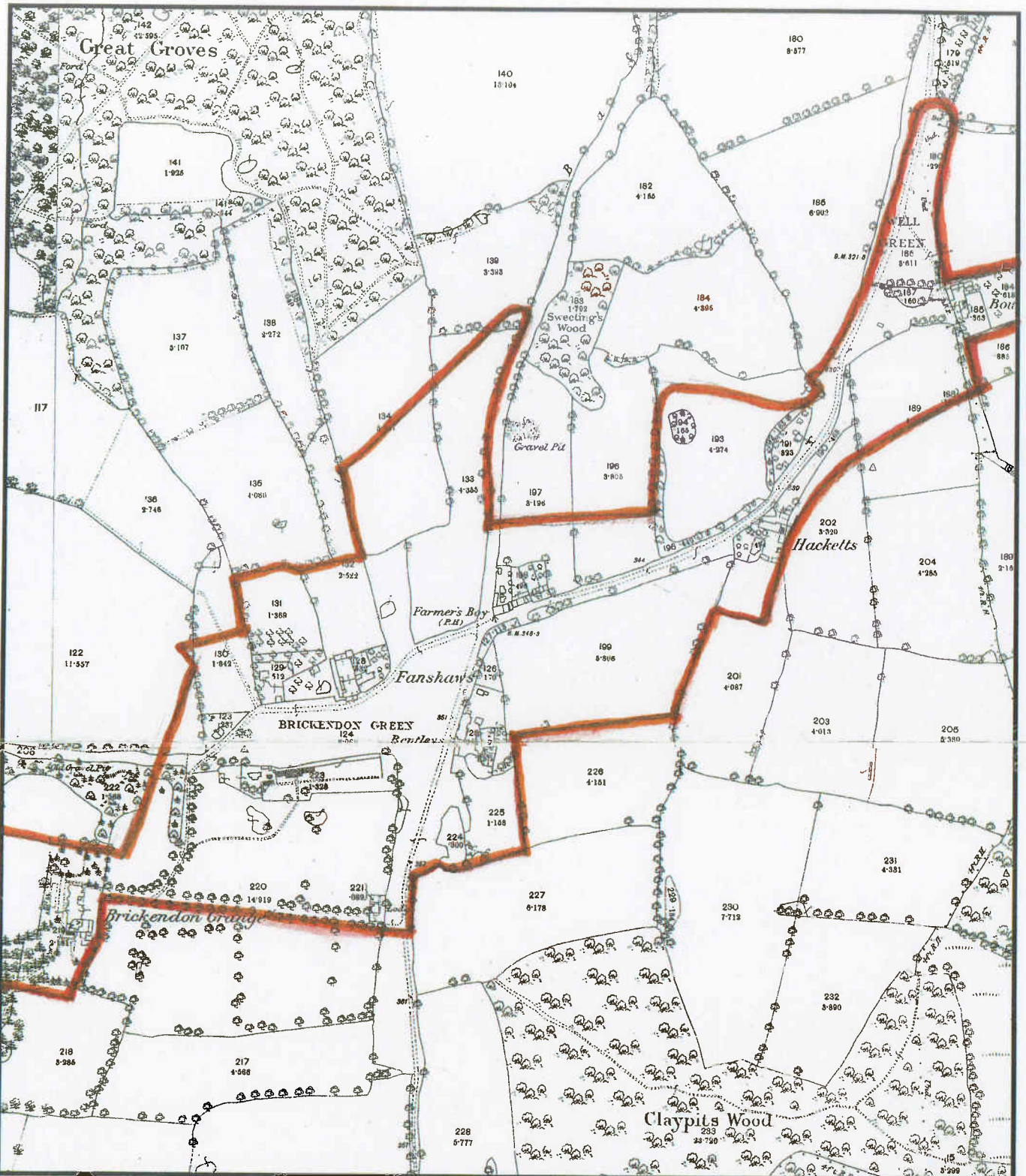

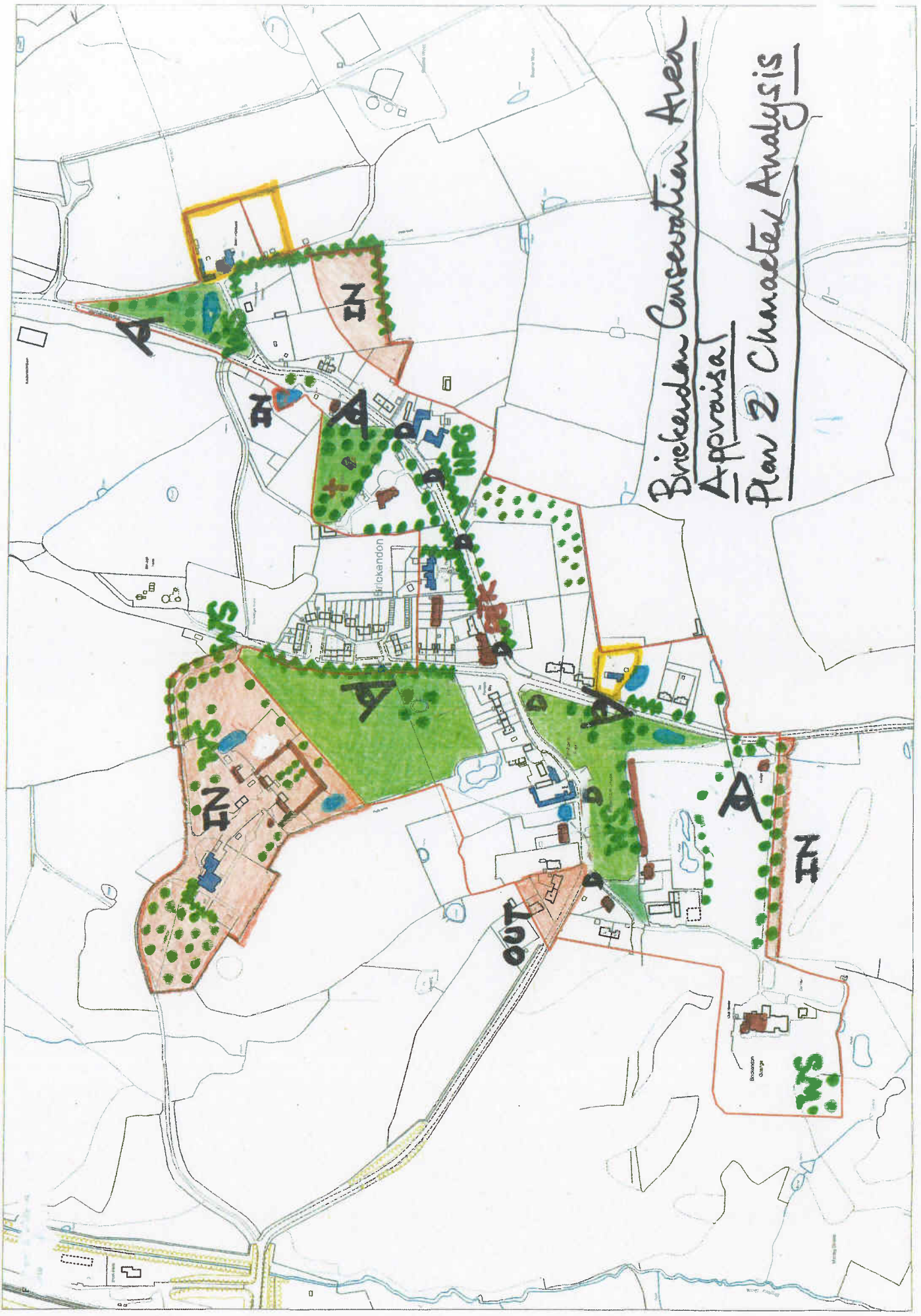


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Brickendon Conservation Area Appraisal
