Inaccurate description of a listed building.	The representation advises the Village Pump and Canopy is supported by five posts not six.	Agreed. Suitable amendment to text made. In due course advise Historic England.
Request to include another listed building in the text.	The representation expressed surprise that reference to Church House had not been included.	Agreed. The text makes it clear that only a selection of listed buildings is mentioned. However the inclusion of a brief description and illustration of Church House is considered appropriate.
