A Challenge 21 scheme shall operate at the premises. Any person who appears to be under 21 years of age shall not be served alcohol unless they produce an acceptable form of identification (passport, photo driving licence, Military Identity card or PASS accredited card).

**c) Public safety**

The public safety objective has been considered in the light of the proposed premises.

The proposed premises will not have an adverse effect on the public safety objective.

The proposed premises will promote the public safety objective in accordance with the Section 182 Guidance.
