## Organisations surveyed: 34 out of a total of 224 Members

## **Report Summary Highlights**

59% said if they hadn't worked with CVS, they probably would not have done and achieved as much.

35% said if they hadn't worked with CVS, they probably would not have got in as much money.

62% strongly agreed that CVS has helped them find out about grants and other sources of funding available to them.

44% strongly agreed that CVS had helped them make bids for grants.

14% strongly agreed CVS has helped them better understand the legal aspects of their work.

32% agreed that CVS help them ensure that their Volunteers are better trained.

41% agreed that CVS help them publicise their services in new or better ways.

Total amount of funding received as a direct result of working with the CVS is £100,644.00!




A high percentage of groups answered not relevant to the questions below.

# 1) Thinking about how things have gone for your organisation over the last 12 months or so, which of these statements is true for you?








# 3) Thinking about getting money in for your organisation over the last 12 months or so, which of these statements is true for you?








4) This question is about how CVS may have helped you run your organisation.

Thinking about the support and advice you and your organisation or group have received from CVS over the last 12 months or so, to what extent do you agree or disagree with these statements?










5) This question is about how CVS may have helped your organisation get funding.
