I write further to my last email confirming receipt of your objections. As you are aware the last date for representations was yesterday.

Your representation was the only representation made and as such I am in the process of organising a licensing sub-committee within the next 20 working days.

During the consultation period the applicant has agreed a number of conditions to be added to their licence, I wish to bring to your attention one of these conditions which may be of interest. This condition reads that

“Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises which could cause a nuisance to nearby properties. Except for ingress and egress through the entrance, doors and windows shall be kept closed (but not locked) whilst regulated entertainment is taking place.”

Taking this condition into account, would you please confirm whether this condition elevates your concern and as such you wish to withdraw your objection or if this condition does not elevate your concern and as such you wish there to be a licensing Sub-Committee hearing.
