Public safety	Y	<p>The TMP that has been submitted to both HCC and the Hertfordshire Constabulary Traffic Management Unit is incomplete, inadequate and includes contradictions: Final site plan shows 2 access points, an in and an out. Plan 2 shows 2 access points but one at a different location to the above. 3 way traffic light plan, shows 1 access point.</p> <p>Three of the major areas of concern are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The proximity of the access points to each other, plus the 6 arm roundabout and the railway level crossing combined with turning movements of vehicles arriving and leaving, as well as other traffic on the wider network - The taxi drop off / shuttle turning point that is indicated on the event plan is not signposted on the entry to the site, thereby causing confusion to drivers. - No clearly signed pedestrian access routes.
To prevent public nuisance	Y	The site is used for a weekly car boot event, Sunday from 08:00 hours until approximately 13:00 hours. This event causes traffic congestion, disruption and inconvenience to the local residents.
