Financial:	It is difficult to place a financial estimate against each option. The timing of developments such as Old River Lane, the leisure centres and the Theatre will have significant impacts on premiums payable, as will insurance market conditions. Essential Reference Paper B details benefits and risks for each option, some of which are financial. If the property portfolio and the insurance market remain stable, the premiums payable are unlikely to alter significantly under options one or two, unless option three remains a possibility. The likely contribution payable for option three is unknown.
