Report title: Suspension of Commercial Waste

## **Summary**

 Businesses face a challenging time in both dealing with and recovering from the Covid 19 pandemic. This decision seeks to provide a temporary simplified process for customers to suspend their commercial waste collections during the period of government lockdown by removing the need for a notice period and allowing for temporary suspension without charge.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DECISION:**

- (a) To allow for the temporary suspension of commercial waste collection contracts at customer request.
- **(b)** To allow for the suspension during the government instigated lockdown with immediate effect from any request, i.e. without notice.

# 1.0 Proposal(s)

- 1.1 To allow for the temporary suspension of commercial waste collection contracts.
- 1.2 To allow for the suspension to be with immediate effect from notification by a customer.

1.3 To allow for the suspension period only to be without charge.

## 2.0 Background

- 2.1 The Covid-19 pandemic has led to a government instigated lockdown requiring the closure of many businesses.
- 2.2 Although some government relief is in place for businesses. It is likely that many of the SME's to which we provide services will suffer hardship as a consequence of the impacts of the virus.
- 2.3 We have started to receive calls from businesses requesting the suspension of contracts to reduce their unnecessary costs during the lockdown period.
- 2.4 The Waste Shared Service client team need a position statement with regard to how to treat customer accounts during the lockdown as the current terms and conditions do not allow for this.
- 2.5 The relief will not impact on any outstanding debt
- 2.6 The relief will not impact on any period where a customer requires a service
- 2.7 The relief will not impact if the customer does not request a suspension.

# 3.0 Reason(s)

- 3.1 This proposal allows a small amount of relief for businesses during the period that they do not require our services.
- 3.2 The period of lockdown is not under the control of local businesses.

## 4.0 Options

- 4.1 Continue to charge all customers full rates regardless of whether they need the service.
- 4.2 Charge no customers during the period

#### 5.0 Risks

- 5.1 There will be a financial impact on the Council dependant on the number of customers who suspend and the number of weeks the government lock down.
- 5.2 There is a reputational risk if the Council is not seen to be supportive to local SME's during the lockdown.
