The parade will be leaving St Andrew's Car Park at 10:30am to march along to Parliament Square, so Millbridge, The Wash, St Andrew's Street, Parliament Square and Castle Street will need to be closed to all traffic from 10:00am. St Andrew's Street and Old Cross could re-open as soon as the parade has passed through (approximately 10:50am). Millbridge, The Wash and Parliament Square should stay closed until 12:00 to allow people to leave the Square after the Service of Remembrance at the war memorial. The parade will continue from Parliament Square across the Gascoyne Way roundabout up Hale Road/Queens Road to All Saint's Church. We anticipate leaving Parliament Square at 11:05am, so Gascoyne Way Roundabout (closed to traffic from all directions), Hale Road and Queens Road route to the church would need to be closed for all traffic from 11:00 until 11:30am (or when the parade has finished marching through). The church service is due to start at 11:30am.

I have attached another map which I have annotated to help with the closures and added the timings to your details below.

Road closure details

- Millbridge and The Wash (B158) starting at the junction with St Andrews Street/North Road at Old Cross and ending at Parliament Square at the Fore Street junction 10:00 – 12:00
- Part of Fore Street starting at Parliament Square and ending at Fore Street at the junction with Church Street (**pedestrianised already**)
- B158 The Wash starting at Parliament Square and ending at Castle Street junction (Gascoyne Way exit) **10:00 12:00**
- Part of Gascoyne Way Northbound starting at the Gascoyne Way Roundabout at the junctions with Hale Road/Queens Road/Parliament Square and ending at the Gascoyne Way Roundabout at the junctions with Fore Street and London Road **11:00 11:30**
- Part of Gascoyne Way Southbound starting at Gascoyne Way Roundabout at the junctions with Hale Road/Queens Road/Parliament Square and ending at the Gascoyne Way Roundabout at the junctions with Fore Street/London Road **11:00 11:30**
