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## Appendix 2 – Wording of the SMAC rule book

- 1. In accordance with Article 64 of the Air Navigation Order Members shall not recklessly or negligently cause or permit an aircraft to endanger any person or property.
- In accordance with Article 63 of the Air Navigation order Members shall not recklessly or negligently act in a manner likely to endanger an aircraft or any person therin"
- 3. Models must comply with an 81dB at 7 metres noise limit, and cannot be flown without a valid Noise Certificate.
- 4. Observe the Flying Restrictions:
  - a) Keep within the designated flying boundary. Do not fly over the fields on the north side of the access track (towards the cottages) except for take-off or landing:
  - b) Flying times and engine running are restricted to:

## Monday to Saturday: 9am to 1pm and 3pm to 7pm Except Christmas Day and Boxing Day

- c) The running of ic engines on a Sunday at Walkern field is not permitted. Members contravening this rule will be dismissed from the club.
- c) Maximum of 4 models in the air at any time
- 5. The safety fence must be placed in front of occupied pits areas when 2 or more people are present. Non-compliance with this rule will invoke a written warning. The Club committee will deal with further offences by an individual as appropriate.
- 6. Engines must only be started in the designated pits area.
- 7. Radio transmitters must have an appropriate channel pendant attached.
- 8. 35 MHz equipment is used. Use of 27 MHz equipment is not allowed. Members must only use the frequency allocated to

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- them by the Club Committee. Use the channel peg board.
- 9. Model take-offs must commence at least 20 feet in front of the pits, preferably from the strip.
- 10. Warn the other pilots of an intended take-off or landing approach.
- 11. Pilots must stand by the designated marker.
- 12. Watch for models landing and taking off when crossing the strip or coming down the track.
- 13. Fixed-wing jet powered aircraft must not be flown at club sites
- 14. Helicopters
  - a) Under no circumstances will a helicopter be run up to take off speed whilst in or near the fixed wing pits.
  - b) The helicopter should be carried a safe distance away from the pit area before lift off is attempted. Flying into or near the pits is not allowed.
  - c) The helicopter pilot's positions on the flying field will be agreed by all the pilots on the day.
- 15. Beginners and new members must be supervised by a committee-approved instructor until the Stage 1 flying test has been passed.
- 16. Children under 18yrs and vulnerable adults must be accompanied by a parent or guardian
