Constitution

- **8.6 Joint Committee Arrangements**
- 8.10 East Herts/Epping Forest District Council/Harlow District Council/Essex County Council and Hertfordshire County Council Harlow and Gilston Garden Town Joint Committee

Purpose

- 8.10.1 This is a Joint Committee of East Herts Council/Epping
 Forest District Council/Harlow District Council/Essex
 County Council and Hertfordshire County Council in
 relation to the Harlow and Gilston Garden Town (HGGT),
 under the provisions of section 10 of the Local
 Government Act 1972 and all regulations made
 thereunder.
- 8.10.2 To co-ordinate and facilitate the delivery of 16,000 homes in the HGGT by 2033, and 7,000 homes in the years after that along with associated infrastructure.
- 8.10.3 To have a range of strategic and local policy decision making powers.

Terms of Reference

- 8.10.4 The operation and scope of the decision making of this
 Joint Committee are set out in the Inter Authority
 Agreement ("IAA") which is attached to the Constitution as
 Appendix 2 "Inter Authority Agreement for the Harlow
 and Gilson Garden Town Joint Committee".
- 8.10.5 The IAA includes the Terms of Reference for the Joint Committee in Schedule 10 which sets out the duties and obligations, roles and responsibilities of the Councils to in relation to the delivery of the Joint Committee's objectives.

Voting

8.10.6 The Joint Committee shall consist of five voting members.
One elected councillor appointed by each Partner
Authority in accordance with that Partner Authority's
constitution. To be eligible for membership of the Joint
Committee, a councillor must either be: (i) a member of
the Executive/Cabinet of their appointing authority; or (ii)
a relevant Portfolio Holder within their appointing
authority; or (iii) an appointed deputy to either the Leader
or a member of the Executive/Cabinet with relevant
portfolio of their appointing authority

Quorum

8.10.7 The quorum of the meeting will be five members.

Administration

8.10.8 The Access to Information Rules (as set out in the Constitutions of the constituent councils) to apply to all meetings.

Review period

8.10.9 The constituent councils will review the Joint Committee's terms of reference at least every five years.
