Decision

Advertise and make the Road Traffic Regulation Order to enable to the introduction of double yellow line (No Waiting at Any Time) waiting restrictions. To maintain vehicular ingress and egress and reduce the risk of obstructive parking that could adversely impact on the operation of the theatre and result in congestion on the adjoining public highway.

Date of Decision

4 January 2024

Reason(s) for decision

The theatre redevelopment project included modification to an area immediately in front of the building. For the purpose of maintaining vehicular access at all times in the service road it is necessary to introduce double yellow line (no waiting at any time) restrictions to mitigate against the risk of obstruction and traffic congestion on the public highway, and to enable civil parking enforcement (CPE) to be delivered through Civil Enforcement Officers.

Details of alternative options considered and rejected

Not progressing the TRO. This would be detrimental to the operation of the theatre; fail to provide Civil Enforcement Officers with the necessary powers to enable them to issue Penalty Charge Notices to

vehicles parked in contravention; not provide a necessary deterrent to motorists.
