<p>The Government has not yet formally defined 'Grey Belt'. It is anticipated that this definition will be set out in a revised National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) which is expected to be published for consultation by the end of July.</p> <p>Only once a definition has been agreed will the Council be in a position to review whether or not it can accommodate any development on 'Grey Belt' land.</p>
