Name of market incentive	Hertford Commercial Market – Four free weeks incentive
How many free / reduced fee sessions?	This is a weekly market, and the proposal is to offer four consecutive weeks free, that is, a free pitch once a week on a Saturday, for four consecutive weeks
Describe the reduction in the fee	When benefitting from the <i>four free weeks incentive</i> , the fee of £163.00 (occasional street trading fee) would not be charged. All other rules and obligations relating to trading at Hertford Commercial Market will apply during the four free weeks incentive period. Note: a trader will not be precluded from applying for a four free weeks incentive at Ware Commercial Market at the same time so long as the four weeks at both markets coincide. In this case, the fee reductions at both markets will apply concurrently.
Is there any other incentive for the stallholder?	No
Are there any obligations on the stallholder in return for benefiting from the reduced fee/incentives?	No
Are there exemptions from benefiting from the reduced fee/incentives?	A stallholder could not benefit from this incentive if: • they have had a <i>four free weeks incentive</i> , during the 18 months prior to applying for the incentive, at any market run by East Herts Council and/or
