This scheme represents a cost- effective way for the council to enable 4no. newly built four bedroom houses to be let at rents below 60% of market rents, akin to social rent levels.

In addition, the council's grant is, in fact, unlocking Paradigm's own internal subsidy such that the combined impact of the council's and registered provider's subsidy is able to fund a significant reduction in the rent of £165 per calendar month, this being down to level which equates to a social rent.
