	Also, to fund the following sustainability project costs as part of the UKSPF activities: - Jigsaw Power- EV Consultancy. £5,370. - SLM – Decarbonisation Plans for Hartham and Grange Paddocks Leisure Centres - £7350 - Contract value extension on Energy Saving Trust e- Learning training to allow a potential of 20 further users to access training.
