Gladstone Road, Ware
Resident Permit Zone - Informal Consultation No. 2

You may recall East Herts Council consulted with Gladstone Road residents about the possibility of introducing resident permit parking in June 2025. While there was overall support for the proposal, with 74% of respondents in favour, the overall response rate (by household) failed to meet the 51% majority threshold required with 40% recorded.

Following residents' engagement with the East Herts Portfolio Holder Tim Hoskin (Executive Member for Environmental Sustainability), the Parking Service developed a draft RPZ plan to share with residents in this consultation, which is included with this letter.

The properties removed from this second round of informal consultation include 1-10 Rosebery House and 67-89 Gladstone Road. The reason for removing them is due to the low level of engagement in the June consultation, and when considering these properties benefit from private off-road parking, which is not shared with other residents.

The current cost of Resident Permit Zone (RPZ) permits & visitor vouchers is shown below:

- First Resident: £75.00 per year
- Second permit: £150.00 per year
- Blue badge holder permits are free
- 1 hour visitor vouchers: £0.17 pence and £0.08 pence for pensioners
- Motorcycle permits: £27.00 per year
- Contractor permits (weekly): £26.00

If at this stage the majority threshold for responses (by household) is not met, the proposal will not be taken forward, and there will be no further opportunity to consult for at least 12 months.

Therefore, it is very important that the council receives your views, even if you don't own a vehicle.


